
**June 2, 2019 – 7th Sunday of Easter:** Our readings today give us something to think about regarding our response to suffer, to remember, and to follow. (Acts 7:50-60, Revelations 2 12-14, 16-17,20, John 17: 20-16)

**June 9, 2019 – Pentecost Sunday:** The Holy Spirit descended on the disciples offering peace and consolation while revealing Jesus as the Christ and Lord of all. Believers can share in Christ's life and become "one body" with many parts and distinct gifts. (John 20: 19-23)

**June 16, 2019 – Trinity Sunday:** It is difficult to hold in tension the humanity of Christ and the mystery of the Trinity; but doing so allows us to respond to the Holy Spirit's guidance as we discern life's new and always changing circumstances. (John 16: 12-15)

**June 23, 2019 – Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi):** In Christ's feeding the multitude and Paul's description of the Eucharist, we are commanded to feed the hungry, challenged to be humble before God, and comforted with the assurance of God's abiding presence with us. (1 Corinthians 11: 23-16, Luke 9: 11b-17)

**June 30, 2019 – 13th Sunday in Ordinary Time:** We are called to discipleship in Christ. Our response should be given freely and with faith in the Spirit to lead us. Even when the cost is great, even when we face rejection or hardship, we must fulfill our mission to proclaim the kingdom of God. (Luke 9: 51-62)
